 - c) DC/18/4756 & DC/18/4757/LBC. 59-60 London Road Halesworth Suffolk IP19 8LS: Strip & relay roof. Replace barge boards. Removal & relocation utility meters. Remove concrete plaster internally & externally. Lime render internally & externally. Raise bedroom one ceiling to expose historic timbers. Insert insulation. Remove porch non-historic. Rewire electrics. Replace plumbing and new combination boiler. Remove non historic partition wall in kitchen 59- Non historic. Replace kitchen, utility and bathroom. Install extraction to kitchen and two bathrooms. Chimney flue liners & two multi fuel stoves. Connect property at ground floor. It was **RESOLVED** that the Committee recommended **approval**.
