

- A temporary road closure order for the Thoroughfare - This is proposed between 9am and 3pm between the Ipswich Building Society and the Angel.
- This will allow pedestrians to have maximum space for social distancing whilst accessing shops and businesses (cyclists will be asked to dismount). Residents and designated businesses will have two-way access at the north end (Bridge Street).
- Deliveries will take place via loading bays in the town centre car park (existing bay by the White Hart and hatched area by HRG Services / Cross Ram).
- Businesses will be allowed to use the two loading bays for offloading.
- Two additional disabled parking bays near the disabled toilets.
- In addition, an application will be submitted to extend no parking in the Market Place from Tuesday evening to attempt to reduce the issues when market access has been restricted by overnight parked cars.
- Please be aware, there are new Parking Attendants in the town and they will be monitoring all civil parking restrictions which include no parking in the Thoroughfare except for unloading and loading.
- Appropriate road signage at:
 - Key points in the town to alert drivers to the road closures and new delivery zones.
 - To warn drivers of pedestrian/vehicle bottlenecks i.e. between The Angel and Halesworth Bookshop where there are narrow pavements.
 - In addition, we will commission appropriate and relevant Halesworth signage to reinforce key safety messages.
- The changes in the town centre will be supported by a simple marketing/communications campaign for the local area.
- The Halesworth Volunteer Centre are generously developing a plan to support the town centre with volunteers who will help keep an eye on pedestrian bottlenecks, general access and offering shopper support (whilst you are restricted to being inside your businesses).
