3. Feedback on the Road Closure implemented on 20/07/20: To consider the feedback obtained from businesses and residents for the temporary road closure in the Thoroughfare and Bridge Street.
4. Road Closure extension options for the Thoroughfare and Bridge Street.

The TTRN will initially be in force for 21 days (20th July – 9th August) but can be extended by a further 21 days. During this period, the Town Council will have to consider what restrictions it feels will be necessary once the maximum period for the TTRNs has expired. The options are:

- a. Extend the Road Closure for a further 21 days (10th August – 30th August)
 - b. Remove the current temporary restrictions; Monday to Saturday 10am – 2pm.
 - c. If the Town Council is content that the scheme as implemented under the TTRN should continue as is (or with modifications), the County Council will promote a TTRO (Temporary Traffic Regulation Order) which lasts up to 18 months.
 - d. However, if the Town Council wants to make the TTRN arrangement permanent, the County Council could promote an Experimental TRO which also lasts up to 18 months. During that period, the experiment would be monitored; the County Council would consider any comments within the first 6 months and decide if it becomes a permanent Order.
 - e. To review any ideas of enabling an effective road closure if option c or d is to be considered.
