5. Planning Applications: To consider the following:
  - a) DC/20/2724/FUL - Proposed commercial side extension to units - Units 1 to 4 Halesworth Business Centre Norwich Road, Halesworth. The Chair had visited the site and explained the position of the proposed extension. The Chair confirmed that access would still be possible to the rear of the units. The extension may also facilitate the need for additional staff. It was then RESOLVED that the Committee recommended approval.

Extend the drop kerb by one kerb to provide additional hard standing for one vehicle, the surface will be permeable material. 10, Queens Drive, Halesworth. The Chair advised that many of the properties in the area had similar extensions and as there were no objections it was RESOLVED that the Committee recommended approval.
