- 2. Declarations of Interest None received
- **3. Minutes of the previous meeting** The minutes from the meeting of the 10th August 2020 were accepted as a true record.

4. Matters arising from the minutes -

LG asked if DT had had any information on Water Voles from Suffolk Wildlife Trust – not yet.

She also asked DT to clarify what the DCO (development consent order) for SZC is. Clerk to send Sustrans cycle recommendations to LG.

5. Chair's Report -

The Green Wall in the Council Offices is now complete.

- **6. River Update** Cllr Thomas is planning to walk the route of the river to map out features and hazards when the weather allows. The tree along Rectory Lane is still to be removed.
- **7. Energy Projects Update** A member of the public asked the Committee whether they were aware of the habitat mitigation planned by EDF at Halesworth by the sewage works. The Clerk will find information and send to the Committee.
- **8. Tree Wardens report -** LS was absent this month.
- **9. Rewilding Halesworth** BC was not here to give an update but TA introduced the group to 'Bee Highways' and will liaise with BC on this.
- 10. Reduction of the use of pesticides in Halesworth BC was absent this month

- 11. Cycle Paths MD attended the Halesworth Neighbourhood Plan cycle discussion group. TA reported that East Suffolk Council have asked the NP group to help update the Halesworth cycle map as part of the overall updating of their cycling and walking strategy. Clerk to circulate map to Committee members.

 Joyce Moseley from the Neighbourhood Plan group joined the meeting.

 As part of the cycling discussion group, she and one other group member have arranged a meeting with Paul Horne at SCC (Transport Strategy, Growth, Highways and Infrastructure) to look at rerouting National Cycle Route one away from the Thoroughfare and to consider a cycle lane on Saxons Way. She will also ask about the possibility of 20mph through the centre of Halesworth.

 A member of the public from the Green Party active transport group bought to Committee's attention that the Government are consulting on the Highway Code currently and that everyone should have their say on this. The update is concerning vulnerable road users pedestrians, particularly children, older adults and disabled people, cyclists and horse riders. Clerk to circulate details.
