Additional notes for WDC Street Collections.

It is the Waveney District Council's Policy with respect to **Lowestoft** to only be able to book one Street Collection to a single organisation on any one day in a particular area; with further requests for additional dates being applied for no more than six weeks before a planned collection.

It is the Waveney District Council's Policy with respect to **Beccles, Bungay, Halesworth and Southwold** to allow charities to book three dates to be booked in advance, with further requests for additional dates applied for no more than ten weeks before a planned collection.

Rubbish

Please note, all rubbish from the street collection must be taken home with you, it must not be put in or near a public bin, as this is classed as 'fly tipping'. Anybody found guilty of fly tipping can be fined up to £50,000.
